- 2. That the Assistant Superintendent, Chief Human Resources Officer is directed to give notice of layoff to the affected classified employees pursuant to the requirements of law.
- 3. That layoff and reduction shall become effective no earlier than 60 days following service of the notice as required by law.
- 4. That any employee laid off pursuant to this Resolution shall be eligible for reemployment pursuant to Education Code section 45298.
