



Textbook adoption Support for Newport-Mesa Unified School District

This proposal presents a plan to support the Newport Mesa Unified School District to continue the process of textbook adoption for grades 6-12 in History-Social Science. This will include three days of training and facilitation to create a tool to analyze textbooks aligned to the new History-Social Science Framework. The scope of the work performed will be between August 2018 and April 2019. The proposal will serve all secondary history-social science teachers in the district who are piloting the textbooks. Throughout all aspects of the professional development and curriculum development, the UCI History Project staff will work with Newport-Mesa administrators and teachers to align instruction to district goals and state standards to meet the needs of Newport-Mesa students. A detailed description and timeline of the proposed professional development is below.
